

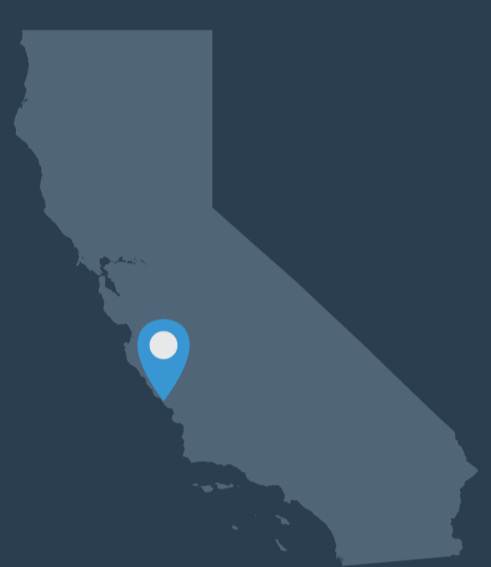


THE MOST EXPENSIVE HOMES IN THE WORLD

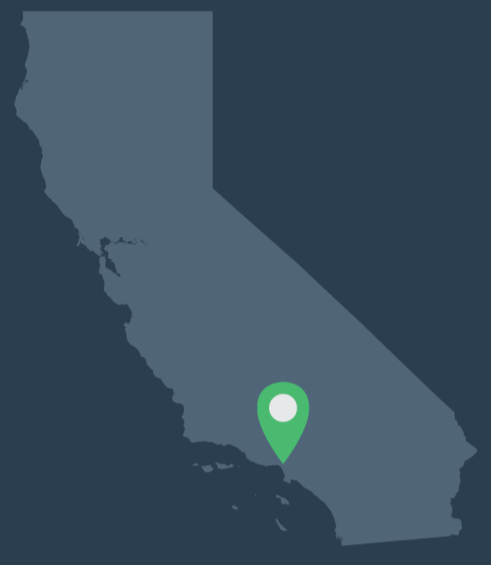
In LA, the Fleur de Lys Mansion sold for \$102 million. It was used for the film "The Green Hornet" and the 2008 Audi Super Bowl commercials



The Hearst Castle is located in San Simeon, California and is valued at \$191 million. The castle has 27 bedrooms and was used in "The Godfather."



In Beverly Hills you can find the Palazzo di Amore, listed for \$195 million. It can host up to 1000 guests, has a ballroom, a revolving dance floor and creates its own wine



In London, Kensington Palace Gardens is valued at \$222 million. The home has 12 bedrooms, a turkish bath, indoor pool, parking for 20 cars and a ballroom



The Fair Field mansion in Sagaponack, New York is valued at \$249 million. Fair Field has 29 bedrooms, 39 bathrooms, its own power plant, a synagogue, two courtyards, an orangery, a home theater, basketball court and bowling alley



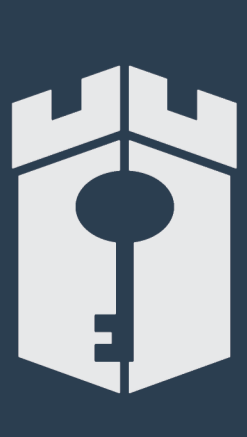
